PLANET 2050

Cummins believes aggressive goals drive environmental action.

PLANET 2050 includes nine goals timed to 2030 to reduce GHG and volatile organic compound emissions. The goals also call for reducing water use, waste generation and more.

DESTINATION ZERO

Cummins' strategy for decarbonization is a roadmap for PLANET 2050's aspiration to completely power customers with net-zero emissions technology by 2050.

Destination Zero calls for advancing zero-emission platforms for those ready today while providing ways for others to cut carbon using our core technologies. We see the drive for climate action as a growth opportunity.

Cummins is developing both hydrogen fuel cells and internal combustion engines fueled by hydrogen.

DELIVERING THE FUTURE

Cummins is bringing to market today the technologies that will power a no-carbon economy in the future:

BATTERY-ELECTRIC: Cummins has deployed more than 6,200 battery modules and powers more than 500 battery-electric buses.

HYDROGEN FUEL CELLS:

The company has deployed more than 2,000 hydrogen fuel cells, and powers the world's first hydrogen-powered train.

ELECTROLYZERS: Cummins' technology to increase the supply of low-carbon hydrogen supports the world's largest PEM electrolyzer in operation.

SOCIAL

Cummins is committed to building stronger communities, the belief that its employees are the company's most important asset and the power of diversity, equity and inclusion.
