

Jacobs Engine Brake™ Service Letter E462

SUBJECT: Control Valve Spring Configuration.

MODELS AFFECTED: 349 and 349A

DATE: June 20, 1997

Jacobs has introduced a new control valve spring group for model 349 and 349A engine brakes. This new group provides improved durability and component retention.

This configuration should be used for all control valve spring related repairs on all 349 and 349A engine brakes. When a control valve spring related repair is required, a P/N 024640 control valve spring group should be used to update all six control valve systems. This service letter replaces services letters 421, 444, 448, and 451.

This new configuration should be used on Jacobs models 349 and 349A. To provide maximum component retention, retaining ring P/N 015561 must be installed with the sharp edge facing up. This provides maximum engagement with the snap ring groove. One control valve group, P/N 024640 is required per engine.

Obsolescence

The model 349/349A Tune-up Kit, P/N 019461 (revision "M") now includes the latest parts. Tune-up kits P/N 019461, revisions "L" and earlier, and P/N 020898 (French Version) are obsolete. The old Control Valve spring group P/N 21854 and the Control Valve Spacer/Cover P/N 021056 are now obsolete.

The Caterpillar Distribution Kit, P/N 020736 (revision "J"), contains the new parts. Obsolete parts contained in earlier distribution kits should be returned individually. Do not return the entire distribution kit.

Warranty Information _____

The Standard Jacobs Warranty applies, refer to warranty procedures P/N 21090.

In order to qualify for warranty reimbursement, when a problem is discovered with any part of the control valve system, the Control Valve Spring Group (P/N 024640) must be installed in all 6 control valve bores.

This is a Jacobs product improvement and is not subject to campaign.
